Virtual Work Club – Thursdays 3pm-5pm

Southampton City Council's Employment Support Team are running a weekly virtual work club for people in Southampton needing information, advice and guidance around employment. The virtual work club will take place every Thursday 3pm-5pm starting on Thursday 25th June 2020.

As part of our response to the ongoing situation, we want to give people the opportunity to drop in to a session where they can get advice from one of our Employment Officers. The virtual work club will be running on Zoom and you can drop in at any time in the 2-hour session. You will have the opportunity to speak 1 to 1 with a member of our team – we will be using Zoom's 'Breakout Rooms' feature to make sure your information is kept confidential, so there is no need for you to worry about discussing your case in front of other clients.
